TREASURING AND RESPONDING TO HIM AS OUR GOOD LAND

- The “land of all lands” as the “gift of gifts”—Col. 2:6a; Gal. 3:14; Eph. 3:8, 18b-19a; Col. 1:12.
- Treasuring His prenuptial preparations—Isa. 62:4b-5; Jer. 31:22b; 1 Cor. 2:9; John 14:3, 23.
- Treasuring Him as “wheat” and “barley”—Deut. 8:8a; John 12:24; 1 Cor. 15:45b; 1 Pet. 1:3; Phil. 3:10.
- Treasuring Him as a land of ascendancy with torrents of life-sustaining water—Deut. 8:7b; 11:11-12; 1 Cor. 12:13; 1 Kings 20:28b; Josh. 15:16-19.
- Treasuring Him as our “land of vines,” “our vineyard,” “our vine,” and “our wine”—Deut. 8:8a; S. S. 1:6b; John 15:4a; S. S. 1:2, 4b; 4:10a; Gen. 49:11.
- Treasuring “our land” over “our wall”—S. S. 1:4a; 2:8-9, 12-13a; cf. Deut. 8:7-8a.
- Treasuring Him as our land of rest—Gen. 2:2-3; Exo. 20:8; 31:17; Matt. 11:28-30; Heb. 4:1, 8-11a, 12.
- Rightly responding to Him as “the land in which we do not lack anything”—Deut. 8:9a; Col. 2:6-7a, 10a, cf. 8-15; Deut. 10:12; 1 Cor. 7:30b; Luke 17:31, 34-36.
